## **SUPPLIES:**

White paper plate
Black construction paper
Crayons and/or colored pencils
Black pipe cleaners
Googly eyes
Feathers
Scissors
Craft glue or hot glue gun

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. Cut the paper plate in half
- 2. Cut a teardrop shape for the wing from the remaining paper plate piece
- 3. Use a saltshaker or other small circular object to trace a circle on the black construction paper. As you cut the quail's head, make a pointed portion of the head for the beak
- 4. Color the body of the quail using red, orange, yellow, blue, and purple. Draw lots of letter U's to make the feathers on the body of the quail
- 5. Color the wing and draw some letter U's for the feathers
- 6. Cut one pipe cleaner into three pieces: two 3-inch pieces for the legs and one 2-inch piece for the topknot. Bend the two 3-inch pieces at about 1 inch.
- 7. Glue the following pieces on the body of the quail:
  - a. Wing
  - b. Head
  - c. Googly eye
  - d. Tail
  - e. Topknot
  - f. Legs
